School Board candidate Ronnie Grigg has investigated this and has scheduled a trip down to the Greenville, SC School District to see how and why THEY are so successful with their nutrition program and what Cleveland County Schools can do to improve their nutrition program. Mr. Grigg invited all the School Board to attend that meeting. Candidate Ronnie Grigg and Danny Blanton and perhaps candidate Aaron Bridges are the only ones who have shown an interest so far in attending (August 2, 2022) this PROACTIVE session on solving a long-term problem at CCS. This should be well remembered in the 2022 School Board elections. More about this in other articles.
